We like Osprey backpacks. 'I've used Osprey bags by preference for the last four years,' CTC MTB's Dan Cook noted in the Feb/Mar 2010 issue. And when we reviewed the Talon 22 in the April/May 2008 issue, Dan Joyce praised it for big days out and multi-day mountain biking: 'There are lots of pockets, internally and externally, even in the waist straps. These are great for dividing up your gear.'

The Osprey Talon range is designed for active outdoor pursuits, and the Talon 22, Talon 11 and Talon 5.5 are ideal for mountain biking. They're very stable and comfortable on your back, thanks to a padded AirScape back panel that

> prevents overheating and Osprey's secure and highly adjustable strapping arrangement. They'll all take a hydration bladder and they each come in two torso sizes, S/M and M/L

> > Thanks to Osprey, we've got five Talon 11 backpacks to give away, each worth £60. The pack's 11-litre capacity (9 for the S/M) will hold everything you need for day rides, and there's a shock-cord on the back for a spare layer. Yet its lightweight construction and limpet-like fit keep it inconspicuous even when riding in tricky terrain.
